### Treasurer Report:

There really isn't much to report since our last meeting for financials. New accounting software is working great!

Biggest things to note are general donations and playground donations (as of today)

\$1,255.00 - general donations – already passed budget of \$1,000

\$885.46 – playground donations rolled over from last year

\$2,996.72 – current year net playground donations (\$3,080 donations less \$83.28 in PayPal processing fees)

\$3,882.18 – TOTAL playground donations available to use

New Business:

Playground Update: The Ten Spin was the winner of the survey and we have reached our fundraising goal to be able add it to our playground! We have notified the district and sales rep to move forward with getting the equipment ordered and are hoping we can get it installed with the main playground soon.

Committee Updates:

- a. Spirit Wear: Spirit Wear will be going home with families this week. There were a lot of orders and working with Heritage Embroidery and Design has been great. There may be some backorders on certain items.
- b. Papa John's Nifty Fifty: Papa John's cards should have gone home yesterday or today. We sold 71 cards.
- c. Conference Dinners: With conferences being in-person this fall we can provide conference dinners again. We are planning on doing tacos on Tuesday and Ronally's on Thursday. We will be asking for donations from families that are able to donate in either in food items, desserts or monetary.
